



## <u>Pre-accreditation/Zero visit at Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences</u> <u>CUAVS – Bahawalpur</u>

The Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences is a public sector university located in Bahawalpur, Punjab, Pakistan. It was established in 2014 on the initiative by the Government of Punjab. The University was established to exploit potential of livestock resources of Cholistan and Southern Punjab as well as to establish a state of the art institution catering the needs of South Punjab for education, research, disease diagnostics, trainings and keeping pace with innovations in the livestock, poultry, wildlife and allied sectors. The university having 03 faculties, 18 departments, 01 institute, 02 teaching hospitals and 06 teaching & research centers.

Three Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC as a convener and Prof (Retd). Dr. Muhammad Younas, Faculty of Animal Husbandry, UAF, Prof. Dr. Umar Farooq Department of Food Science and Technology, MNSUA, Multan and Prof. Dr. Muhammad Irfan Anwar Faculty of Veterinary Sciences, BZU, Multan as members conducted Pre-Accreditation/Zero visit of Animal Sciences, Food Science & Technology and Poultry Science at Cholistan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences Bahawalpur.
