Accreditation visit of Food Science & Technology (FST) degree Program at University of Central Punjab- Lahore

Later, Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC shared the accreditation standards (8) and substandard (73) besides the importance and significance of accreditation along with previous AIC recommendations.

Then later, Dr. Kanza Awan, HoD, FST, UCP, Lahore gave a detailed presentation of departmental achievements as per itinerary. Different queries by subject expert were discussed during presentation. During the interaction with students, information on the teaching methodology, course completion and student assessment was obtained and found satisfactory. Then AIC visited departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices and Food Processing Hall. After the payer and lunch, two major activities (curriculum review and meeting with individual faculty) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and results. AIC held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level.

In the closing session, the AIC members shared their observations where improvement was required. Dr. Kanza Aziz Awan, HoD, FST, UCP, Lahore acknowledged the feedback and assured prompt actions to address and improve the identified areas. In this session, Pro-rector, Dean, HoD and other faculty members were also present. Dr. Hadia Awan.
