



## Accreditation and Pre-accreditation/Zero visit at KFUEIT-Rahim Yar Khan

The establishment of the Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering & Information Technology (KFUEIT), Rahim Yar Khan in 2014 started its journey with merely 4 rooms, 5 faculty members and admission intake in 4 degree programs. It is named after the famous Sufi poet Khwaja Ghulam Fareed and a beautiful and state of the art campus is spread over 275 acres and is equipped with all modern facilities where more than 600 employees including 200 teaching faculty members are performing their duties in making this university a premium institution of the country in days to come. After the admissions of fall 2019, KFUEIT registered its name in leading universities of country by growing to 16 departments, 94 degree programs, over 100 PhD qualified faculty members and crossing milestone of 10,000 students.

Five Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Rajwana, Chairperson NAEAC as a convener, Prof. Dr. Nazim Hussain, Department of Agronomy, BZU, Multan, Prof. Dr. Muhammad



Razaq, Department of Entomology, BZU, Multan, Dr. Ghulam Hassan Abbasi, Institute of Agro-Industry & Environment, IUB, Dr. Muhammad Amin, Department of Horticultural Sciences, IUB, Dr. Gulzar Akhtar, Department of Horticulture, MNS-University of Agriculture, Multan and Prof. Dr. Saeed Akhtar, Faculty of Food Science & Nutrition, BZU, Multan as members conducted Accreditation visit of Agronomy, Entomology & Horticulture degree programs and Pre-Accreditation/Zero visit of Environmental Science & HND degree programs at KFUEIT- Rahim Yar Khan.

Dr. Shahzad Murtaza, Dean of all Faculties, Engr. Dr. Ahmed Sohaib, Director of ICT, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan and HoDs of all respective departments received and welcomed the guests. Dr. Shahzad Murtaza, Dean of all faculties chaired the inaugural session. After the recitation of Holy Quran, he formally welcomed all evaluators. Engr. Dr. Ahmed Sohaib, Director Information & Computer Technology (ICT), KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan highlighted the major accomplishments and future plan of the university. Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Rajwana, Chairperson NAEAC presented a brief overview of NAEAC activities and achievements made so far. During the inaugural session, Dr. Shahzad Murtaza, Dean of Faculty, Dr. Ahmed Sohaib, Director of ICT, Dr. Yasir Niaz, HoD, Department of Agricultural Engineering, Dr. Farhan Chughtai, HoD, Department of HND & FST and Dr. Adnan Noor Shah, Agriculture Coordinator, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan and other faculty members were present.

Later on, AICs moved to relevant departments where detailed presentations and discussions were held. Each HoD briefed respective AIC in detail about working of the department and achievements in terms of student graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AICs also visited respective departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, glasshouse, faculty offices, experimental research area and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the departments. After lunch, two major activities (curriculum review and meeting with individual faculty) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and results. AICs held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level.

In the informal concluding session of the visit the program evaluators shared their observations with Prof. Dr. Muhammad Suleman Tahir, VC, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan, Dr. Muhammad Saeed, Registrar, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan and other officials including Dean, Director ICT, HoDs and other faculty members. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Suleman Tahir thanked NAEAC team for their day-long deliberations and inspection visit. In order to raise the threshold for education and increase the value of the graduates produced, he promised that the recommendations given by the AICs would be put into action.
