

## Review Meeting of Agriculture Degree Programs- Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan

The Ghazi University (GU), Dera Ghazi Khan was established in 2012 and became functional on 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2014. Since its inception, GU has been operated only on additional charge basis. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Tufail (TI) assumed the charge as a permanent Vice Chancellor (VC), on 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2018. There are four faculties including Faculty of Agricultural Sciences in the University. Under the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, 09 departments are functional.
