<u>Pre-Accreditation/Zero Visit of Environmental Sciences Degree Program at</u> University of Sindh-Jamshoro

May 8, 2023

University of Sindh was constituted under the University of Sindh Act. No. XVII of 1947 passed by the Legislative Assembly of Sindh. The Act of 1972 under which the university is presently functioning provided for greater autonomy and representation of teachers. The development of the present Campus at Jamshoro, about 15 kilometer from Hyderabad on the right bank of River Indus now designated as Allama Imdad Ali Imam (AII), Kazi Campus, was started in late fifties. There are presently 4 Law Colleges and 74 Degree and Post Graduate Colleges (including 16 Private Colleges) affiliated to the university. The university comprises of 06 campuses and 09 faculties.

An Accreditation Inspection Committee (AIC) comprising of Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC as a convener, Prof. Dr. Inayatullah Rajpar, Dean, Faculty of Crop Production, Sindh Agriculture University, Tandojam as member conducted Zero/Pre-accreditation visit of Environmental Sciences at University of Sindh, Jamshoro.

Dr. Amanullah Mahar, Director, Center for Environmental Sciences, University of Sindh, Jamshoro received and welcomed the guests. Then AIC moved directly to the Center of Environmental Sciences where Dr. Amanullah Mahar, Director presented the departmental achievements as per itinerary provided by NAEAC. AIC visited departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty office and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the department. individual faculty) were carried out. Each course file on LMS, was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and results. AIC held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level and student teacher interaction.
