Quality Assurance & Accreditation Awareness Seminar at Saint Mary's College-Gujranwala

Saint Mary's College (SMC) was established in Gujranwala since 1979. It is registered under the Punjab Charity Act 2018 having registration number PBGRW-6884055823662557. The institution takes pride in its alumni, who have excelled in various fields and have made significant contributions to society. The HND degree program was initiated in 2017, currently 135 students are enrolled and 4 teaching faculty (3 MPhil & 1 DND) in HND Department.

A Quality Assurance & Accreditation Awareness Seminar was conducted at SMC, Department of Human Nutrition and Dietetics (HND). Dr. Fatima Shahid, HoD, HND and Dr. Rabiya Jamil, Lecturer received and welcomed the guests Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary, NAEAC and Mr. Abdullah, IT Coordinator, NAEAC.
