



<u>Pre-Accreditation/Zero Visit of Degree Programs of Animal Science, Human Nutrition &</u> <u>Dietetics and Poultry Science at UAF Sub-Campus Toba Tek Singh</u>

The UAF Sub-Campus Toba Tek Singh was established on June 5, 2005 as per vision of the then Governor/Chancellor, General (R) Khalid Maqbool that universities should develop programs for the benefit of local masses. District Toba Tek Singh is the second largest hub of poultry after Karachi and it was felt that appropriate knowledge and skills about poultry education must be disseminated to the farmers in addition to producing qualified professionals in Poultry Science.

Three Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Irfan Anwar, Faculty of Veterinary Sciences, Bahauddin Zakariya University, Multan as members conducted Zero/Pre-accreditation visit of the respective departments at the Sub-Campus Toba Tek Singh.

Dr. Nisar Ahmad, Principal, UAF Sub-Campus welcomed NAEAC team and held an informal meeting with them. In the inaugural session Dr. Umar Farooq, HoD Poultry Science gave a brief history and achievements of the sub campus.

Later on, AICs visited the relevant departments where detailed presentations and discussions were held. Each HoD briefed respective AIC in detail about the department working and achievements in terms of student graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AICs







also visited respective departmental labs, classrooms, library, glasshouse, faculty offices and experimental research area and held individual meetings with faculty members to know the level of satisfaction and students of the departments to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the departments.

In the concluding session, the program evaluators shared their observations with the Principal and other officials. Dr. Nisar Ahmad thanked NAEAC team for their deliberations and inspection visit. He assured that, the recommendations made by AICs would be implemented for the uplift of education standard and augment the market value of the graduates produced.
