The Mirpur University of Science and Technology (MUST), Mirpur was established in 2009 by up-grading Mirpur Campus of the University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (UAJK), Muzaffarabad. With the inception of the UAJK in 1980, the College of Engineering and Technology, the College of Home Economics and Institute of Islamic Studies were established as its constituent colleges and institute. The University consists of 06 faculties, 03 campuses, 35 departments and 52 affiliated colleges. The University is offering more than 80 BS and MS programs. 1st Session of Human Nutrition and Dietetics (HND) program was started in 2019 and 148 students are currently enrolled in HND.
