

Accreditation visit of Food Science & Technology (FST) at Govt. College Women University Faisalabad

Government College Women University Faisalabad (GCWUF) started its journey as an intermediate college in 1934. It was promoted to Degree College in the year 1944 and postgraduate disciplines were introduced in 1985. The long journey that started with the humble beginning, reached its climax when the status of University was granted on 5th January 2013. There are 04 faculties including faculty of science and technology. The university offers 31 Bachelor, one Associate Degree in ADE, B.Ed. (1.5 year), 17 Master, 10 M.Phil. and 05 PhD degree programmes in different faculties.

An Accreditation Inspection Committee (AIC) comprising of Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Rajwana, Chairperson NAEAC as a convener, Prof. Dr. Fauzia Yusuf Hafeez, Vice Chairperson, NAEAC, Prof. (Retd). Dr. Asma Khalid, Director QEC, GC Women University, Faisalabad, Dr. Saima Tehseen, Incharge, FST, GCWU and Dr. Rizwana Batool, Assistant Professor, FST, GCWUF received and welcomed the guests. The inaugural session was started with the recitation of Holy Quran. Dr. Asma Khalid, Director QEC highlighted the major accomplishments and future plan of the university. Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Rajwana, Chairperson, NAEAC presented a brief overview of NAEAC activities, achievements made so far and shared the previous AIC recommendations of FST department. During the inaugural session, Registrar, Director QEC, Deans, HoD and other faculty members were present.

Later on, AIC moved to relevant department where detailed presentation and discussion was held. Prof. Dr. Saima Tehseen, Incharge, FST, GCWU, Faisalabad briefed the AIC in detail about working of the FST department and achievements in terms of student graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AIC also visited respective departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library and faculty offices. Subject expert held individual meetings with students to get an insight teaching/working environment in the department. AIC also held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level.

In the exit meeting, program evaluators shared their observations with the Director QEC, Dean, Incharge, FST Department and other faculty members and HoD, FST assured that the recommendations made by AIC would be implemented to raise the standard of education and to improve the skills of the graduates.
