

Accreditation visit of Agriculture and Allied degree Programs at Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering & Information Technology (KFUEIT)- Rahim Yar Khan

The Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering & Information Technology (KFUEIT), Rahim Yar Khan in 2014 started its journey with merely 4 rooms, 5 faculty members and admission intake in 4 degree programs. It is named after the famous Sufi poet Khwaja Ghulam Fareed. A state of the art campus is spread over 275 acres and equipped with all modern facilities. Currently 600 employees including 200 teaching faculty members are performing their duties.

Three Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Prof. Dr. Fayyaz-ul-Hassan, Chairperson NAEAC as a convener, Prof. (Retd). Dr. Muhammad Abid, Department of Soil Science, Bahauddin Zakariya University (BZU), Multan, Prof. Dr. Saeed Akhtar, Dean, Faculty of Food Science & Nutrition, BZU, Multan and Prof. Dr. Umar Farooq, Coordinator, Faculty of Food & Home Sciences, MNSUA- Multan as members conducted Accreditation visit of Environmental Science, Food Science & Technology and Human Nutrition & Dietetics degree programs at KFUEIT- Rahim Yar Khan. Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC and Mr. Muhammad Faraz Afzal, Assistant Director Coordination, NAEAC also accompanied the AICs.

Prof. Dr. Muhammad Sagir, Registrar, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan, HoDs of relevant departments and other faculty members received and welcomed NAEAC and AICs team. The inaugural session was held in the conference room of V.C. office where Prof. Dr. Shahzad Murtaza, Vice Chancellor, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan chaired this session and formally welcomed all subject experts. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Sagir highlighted the major accomplishments and future plans of the university. Later, Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC shared the accreditation rubrics (8) and subcriteria (73) besides the importance and significance of accreditation along with previous AICs recommendations of three departments Environmental Science, Food Science & Technology and Human Nutrition & Dietetics degree programs.

Then AICs moved to relevant departments where detailed presentations of departmental accomplishments as per itinerary were given by relevant HoDs. AICs visited departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices, experimental research area, support facilities and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the departments. After the lunch, two major activities (curriculum review and meeting with individual faculty) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and results. AICs held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level and student teacher interaction.

Prof. Dr. Shahzad Murtaza, Vice Chancellor, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan chaired the concluding session where program evaluators/experts shared their observations. Prof. Dr. Shahzad Murtaza thanked NAEAC team for their day-long deliberations and inspection visit and assured that the recommendations made by AICs would be implemented to increase the standard of education.
