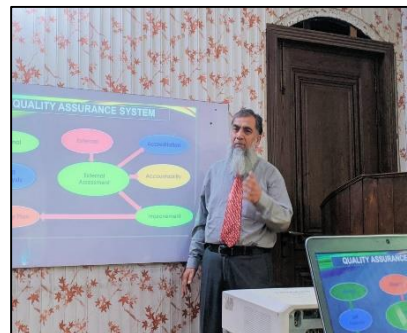


Quality Assurance & Accreditation Awareness Seminar for HND at Rise College- Lahore

RISE College started its journey in 2008 with 13 teachers and around 200 students. It has now been expanded to a network of 5 campuses in 3 major cities. The Fatehgarh Campus offers 8 BS Programs including Human Nutrition & Dietetics (HND) in affiliation with GC University Faisalabad. Current enrollment in BS Human Nutrition and Dietetic is 10 students. There are 3 (2 MPhil (PHD Scholars) and 1 Doctor of Nutrition Sciences) qualified faculty members working in HND.

Dr. Abdul Ghaffar introduced the NAEAC, explained the evaluation criteria of accreditation process which comprised of 8 standards and 73 substandard and impact of accreditation on quality improvement through the data of last 14 years.
