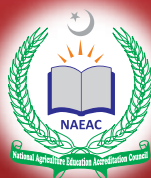


Paid Internship on Food System Transformation by GAIN

With a marvelous history of 137 years of excellence, the University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (UVAS), Lahore is now positioned among top ten Universities of Pakistan. Originally it was established as a school in 1882, it was later transformed into a college by the end of nineteenth century. Realizing the importance of livestock and poultry sectors in the economy of the county and growing need of human resource and research work in veterinary & animal sciences and allied fields in the country, this historic institution was upgraded as university in 2002. Presently, UVAS comprises of 23 departments in five faculties, four institutes and two constituent colleges along with seven affiliated institutes. The university has over 332 faculty members including 186 Ph.D., UVAS offers 26 undergraduate, 30 M.Phil. and 23 Ph.D. degree programs in different areas along with 3 diploma courses and a number of need based short trainings and certificate courses for

Currently, there are 4 faculties and 4,000 enrolled students. AUST initiated FST program in fall 2021 and currently enrolled students in FST are more than 60.

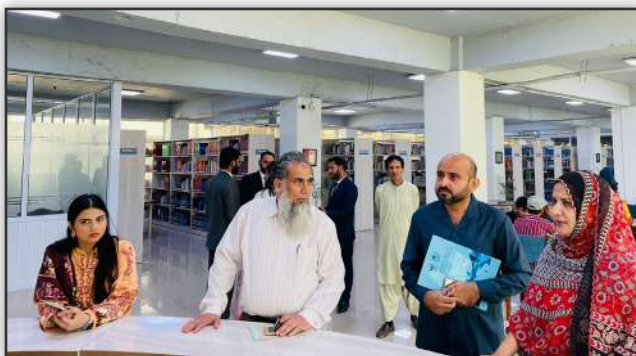
Pre-Accreditation/Zero visit of HND degree Program at Hamdard University- Islamabad Campus

Hamdard University is a first private research university in Pakistan with campuses in Karachi and Islamabad. It was founded in 1991 by the renowned philanthropist Hakim Said of the Hamdard Foundation. Hamdard University Islamabad Campus is located adjacent to Comsats University. This Campus has 6 faculties including Faculty of Eastern Medicines where HND program is being offered. HND was initiated in 2022. Currently 81 students are enrolled.
