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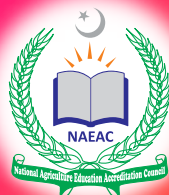

It has 991 full-time/regular and 300 part-time faculty members involved in teaching/research and 49,520 on-campus students (29,588 Morning, 18,838 Evening and 1,094 Diploma students).
